## WELCOME TO OUR CAMPGROUND

For your comfort and safety, the following rules are in place. We reserve the right to enforce all rules.

- **QUIET TIME is 12am- 8am**
- **ALL CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18** are to be on their lot by midnight; **be sure children know their Lot Number**
- **GAMES** (washer toss, cornhole, etc.) **must be finished BY 11PM** as a courtesy to your neighbors
- **Checkout Time** is 1pm. If you wish to stay later, you must notify the office upon check-in to see if site is available
- Tents are not permitted
- Drivers are to obey the **10km/h** posted speed limit. Those who do not will not be permitted to drive past the gate
- **ONE VEHICLE PER SITE**. Additional vehicles must be parked outside the main gate in the appropriate parking areas, otherwise the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense. No parking on empty sites
- **OFFICE HOURS** are 11am-9pm. Propane, firewood, sewer gaskets (doughnut-all trailers are to have) and ice are available for purchase
- **VISITORS MUST REGISTER** and pay the visitor fees. **FAMILY MEMBERS are those who live in the same household** and are not required to pay fees; they should be noted on your file to avoid confusion. Any unregistered guests will be asked to leave immediately
- **BICYCLES**, skateboards, scooters, rollerblades, radios and toys are not allowed in the buildings or pool **AREAS OR AFTER DARK**
- **E-BIKES, ELECTRIC SCOOTERS ARE NOT PERMITTED**
- **NO SMOKING, VAPING, FOOD, DRINKS PERMITTED IN POOL AREA**, except water
- **NO LARGE FLOATS PERMITTED IN EITHER POOL**; small floats/noodles only
- **PLAYGROUND** is to be used to play games and sports. **NO FOWL LANGUAGE WILL BE TOLERATED**
- **DOGS** must always be kept on a leash and cleaned up after. **CANS AROUND THE PARK ARE FOR PET WASTE ONLY**
- **LAUNDRY FACILITIES** are available from **9am-10pm daily**; NO clotheslines permitted
- **FIRES MUST BE OUT BY MIGNIGHT** and are allowed in fire rings only which are not to be moved without office approval. Wood must not exceed 16" in length and there is to be minimal storage on site. No wood chopping permitted. Trees are not to be climbed, cut or damaged.
- **PORTABLE RADIOS** – please keep them off Channel 1 as it's used for STAFF
- **GARBAGE** is to be put in designated dumpsters by Rec Hall in tied bags only. CARDBOARD and other bulk items are not permitted in the dumpsters
- **SMOKING OF CANNABIS** is NOT permitted inside the campground with the exception of inside your trailer, with the conditions that the windows and doors are closed. IF you choose to smoke cannabis, you can do so outside the gate, away from the public. Secondhand smoke which affects other campers and will not be tolerated
